-OUR INTINERARY-

DAY 1 SUNDAY, October 21, 2012

IN ROUTE TO ISTANBUL-TURKEY (IST airport) Our Holy Land adventure begins as we depart from our departure city on an overnight flight to Istanbul-Turkey. The Group will meet in New York, JFK International Airport. Our Delta Airlines flight departs at 5:15pm arriving in Istanbul on Oct 22nd at 10:30am. Complimentary meals and beverages are served on board. (Please Note: The above flight time may change, as the airlines adjust flight schedules.)

DAY 2 MONDAY, OCTOBER 22nd

ARRIVE ISTANBUL-TURKEY —On arrival in Istanbul we will be met by our personal guide and transported via private motor coach for our first glimpse of Turkey! We will take a brief tour of the city sights and enjoy many of the great landmarks Istanbul has to offer as we travel to the Cruise ship to check in. We will have the opportunity to visit the most important monuments from the Christian era of the city during our 2 days in Istanbul. Important sites include: St. Sophia Museum, Hippodrome, Spice Market, Underground Cistern, Chora Church Museum and Greek Orthodox Patriarchate and the Grand Bazaar. The **Grand Bazaar** is one of the largest and oldest covered markets in the world, with more than 58 covered streets and over 4,000 shops which attract between 250,000 and half a million visitors daily.

When we arrive at the Cruise Terminal we will check-in and receive our SeaPass Card for entry on and off the ship and to our cabins. Once you have checked in you are free to relax, freshin-up, explore the ship or take a stroll in downtown Istanbul. The Cruise Terminal is located within walking distance of many shops and activities. We will be docked in Istanbul overnight so you will have all evening to venture out and enjoy the city. NOTE: Any sightseeing, entry fees, and meals not onboard the ship will be at your own expense.

NOTE: Ground transport to the ship is included in the Trip Package Price.

DAY 3 TUESDAY, OCTOBER 23rd

2nd DAY IN ISTANBUL-TURKEY —Depart the ship at 7am and be met by our personal guide and transported via private vehicle for a Tour day in Turkey. **We will visit important sites as:**

Hagia Sophia (from the Greek: **Ἁγία Σοφία**, "Holy Wisdom)—is a former Orthodoxpatriarchal basilica, and now a museum in Istanbul, Turkey. From the date of its dedication in 360 until 1453, it served as the Greek Patriarchal cathedral of Constantinople, except between 1204 and 1261, when it was converted to a Roman Catholic cathedral under the Latin Patriarch of Constantinople of the Western Crusader established Latin Empire. It was opened as a museum on 1 February 1935. The Church was dedicated to the *Logos*, the second person of the Holy Trinity. Although it is sometimes referred to as Sancta Sophia (as though it were named after Saint Sophia), *sophia* is the phonetic spelling in Latin of the Greek word for wisdom – the full name in Greek being **Ναός τῆς Ἁγίας τοῦ Θεοῦ Σοφίας**, "Church of the Holy Wisdom of God". Famous in particular for its massive dome, it is considered the epitome of Byzantine architecture and is said to have "changed the history of architecture." It was the largest cathedral in the world for nearly a thousand years, until Seville Cathedral was completed in 1520.

Chora Church—The **Church of Holy Savior in Chora** (the *Chora Museum*), is considered to be one of the most beautiful examples of a Byzantine church. The interior of the building is covered with fine mosaics and frescoes. The Chora Church was originally built outside the walls of Constantinople, to the south of the Golden Horn. Literally translated, the church's full name was the **Church of the Holy Saviour in the Country**. The last part of that name, **Chora**, referring to its location originally outside of the walls, became the shortened name of the church. The original church on this site was built in the early 5th century, and stood outside of the 4th century walls of Constantine the Great. The name must have carried symbolic meaning, as the mosaics in the narthex describe Christ as the *Land of the Living*.

RETURN to the ship 1pm and prepare to sail to next port, Kusadasi.

DAY 4 WEDNESDAY—October 24th

ARRIVE PORT OF KUSADASI-TURKEY

Depart the Ship at 8am and be met by our Private guide and transportation for our Day Tour of Kusadasi.

We will visit important sites as:

ANCIENT CITY OF EPHEBUS —Ephesus was one of the seven churches of Asia that are cited in the Book of Revelation. The city was the site of several 5th century Christian Councils. It is also the site of a large gladiators' graveyard. Today's archaeological site lies 3 kilometers southwest of the town of Selçuk, in the Selçuk district of İzmir Province, Turkey. Ephesus was an important center for Early Christianity from the AD 50s. From AD 52–54, Paul lived in Ephesus, working with the congregation and organized missionary activity into the hinterlands. He became embroiled in a dispute with artisans, whose livelihood depended on selling the statuettes of Artemis in the Temple of Artemis (Acts 19:23–41). He wrote between 53 and 57 AD the letter 1 Corinthians from Ephesus (possibly from the "Paul tower" close to the harbour, where he was imprisoned for a short time). Later Paul wrote the Epistle to Ephesians while he was in prison in Rome (around 62 AD). Ephesus was one of the seven cities addressed in Revelation (Revelation 2:1–7), indicating that the church at Ephesus was strong. We will also visit **The House of The Virgin Mary, St. John's Basilica (believed to be the burial site of John the Apostle)** and possibly the ruins of Laodicea if time permits.

RETURN TO THE SHIP for evening dinner meal. Our group dinner seating time is 8:45pm.

NOTE: Cost of this Tour is included in the Trip Package. (Tips & Lunch meal not included)

DAY 5 THURSDAY –October 25th

SEA DAY— Relax, enjoy and explore the cruise ship. Morning Bible Class at 10am and Evening Service at 7pm. We are blessed to have traveling with us Dr. Gaetano & Rev. Natalie Sicilia of Bible Faith Church in Toronto, Ontario. Along with Pastor Frey, we will be tremendously blessed by the anointed teaching and instruction we will receive during our trip. Bring your Bibles and a pen. Note sheets are included in your trip book.

DAY 6 & 7 FRIDAY & SATURDAY –October 26/27th

ARRIVE PORT OF ALEXANDRIA, EGYPT— You are FREE to explore these 2 days in Alexandria, Egypt at your leisure. We will not have any scheduled private tours or group activities. You can check with the ship's Excursion Desk for land tours or day trips you can purchase.

Possible sites you may want to visit: (The **Sphinx** , Pyramids of Egypt, Alexandria Archeological Museum, City Tour)

DAY 8 SUNDAY –October 28th (ISRAEL)

We will begin this Sunday with a Morning Worship Service onboard at 9am.

ARRIVE PORT OF ASHDOD (Jerusalem) — Arrive in Port at 10am and will depart the ship at 11am. We will be met by our Private Tour Guide and Transport for a Day of Touring Jerusalem. Our Tour will include:

MOUNT OF OLIVES (Acts 1:8). We'll view the cave and a cloister which bears plaques of the Lord's Prayer in 62 different languages. Next is a spectacular view of the Old City which we'll enjoy before walking down the slope to the tear-shaped church of **Dominus Flevit** (Luke 19:41-44), commemorating the place where Jesus wept over His beloved Jerusalem. We continue our descent to the **GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE** (Mat. 26:36) with its ancient olive trees. The gardener may unlock the gate allowing our group to enter a private part of the olive grove. Across the Kidron Valley, we visit the **HOUSE OF CAIAPHAS** also known as – The Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu (John 18:12). From here it's a short walk to the **POOL OF BETHESDA**, where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle, (John 5:1-31) and the nearby Church of St. Anne's where we'll wait our turn to sing a song – the acoustics are simply amazing! After visiting the **CHURCH of ST. ANNE**, the traditional site of the birthplace of Mary, the mother of Jesus, we continue our stroll to the **LITHOSTROTOS of ANTONIO FORTRESS**, also known as 'The Pavement' (John 19:1-19). In this courtyard, as lots were cast for His garments, Jesus was stripped, beaten, and later led away to be crucified. Nearby, we view the **ARCH of ECCE HOMO**, where according to tradition, Pontius Pilate uttered the words, "Behold the Man", after Christ's scourging (John 19:5).

We then follow in His steps along the traditional **VIA DOLOROSA** to **CALVARY-the CHURCH of the HOLY SEPULCHRE**. (Luke 23), and the **GARDEN TOMB** (John 19:38). In this serene garden setting, we see the places of the crucifixion, burial and resurrection of our Lord, culminating our time together with a **Celebration of Worship and Communion**. We will also visit the **WESTERN WALL** and shopping at the Arab Market. If time permits we may visit the Illuminated Walls at dusk. **RETURN** to the ship for dinner. (Group seating at 8:45pm)

NOTE: This Tour is included in the Trip Package Price. (Tips/lunch not included)

DAY 9 MONDAY –October 29th (ISRAEL)

PORT OF ASHDOD (Jerusalem) — Depart the ship at 7am. We will be met by our Private Tour Guide and Transport for a Full Day of Touring. Our Tour will include:

A visit to **MASADA**, King Herod the Great's fortress/palace built in the midst of the desert. First we'll learn the story of the Jewish zealots who chose death atop Masada in 73 AD rather than becoming slaves to their Roman conquerors. Then it's off to the summit by cable car to view the exquisitely restored archeological remains of the palace complex. If time permits we will stop off briefly at **the DEAD SEA** for a swim. Relax and take time to enjoy the buoyancy of this highly therapeutic Dead Sea water; it's simply indescribable!

Next, we will explore the ancient **CITY of DAVID** with a knowledgeable guide – including the new excavation of the Pool of Siloam. The **Pool of Siloam** is mentioned in John 9:11, when Jesus cured a blind man with a mud mixture and told him to go wash it from his eyes. Recent excavations in the City of David area of [Jerusalem](#) have uncovered what may be the very pool where Jesus performed the miracle, just 50 meters from the traditional site. The tour of the **City of David in Jerusalem** begins with a breathtaking observation point overlooking Biblical Jerusalem which sends visitors 3,800 years back in time to the days of Abraham, when the first foundations of the city were laid. The journey quickly heads underground to some of the newest archaeological excavations at the site. Excavations on the site of David's City have brought to light part of the Jebusite ramparts of 4000 years ago, Israelite houses and fortifications from the time of King David, as well as later walls and towers. Part of the underground water system, also still remains. Excavations have revealed remains of Canaanite settlements from before the time of King David, houses from the period of Judah's kings and remnants of what may have been David's citadel. The underground tour finally ends at the Gihon Spring, the major water source of Jerusalem for over 1,000 years and where, according to the Book of Kings, Solomon was anointed king.

NOTE:

- The Masada cable car fee is not included in the Trip Price. If you want to ride the cable car up to the top the fee is \$15 per person.
- If you want to swim in the Dead Sea the cost is \$12 per person. Changing rooms are available.
- The City of David portion of the Tour is not included in the Trip Package Price. The City of David Tour with a guide cost: \$60 per person. This Tour is approx. 3 hours and can be very strenuous (requires lots of walking on uneven stones and rocks.) For those not wanting to take the City of David Tour, we will arrange with the driver a place where you can shop, walk around or sit and wait for the City of David group to return.
- Tips/Lunch is **NOT INCLUDED**.

RETURN to the ship for dinner. (Group dinner seating at 8:45pm)

DAY 10 TUESDAY –October 30th (ISRAEL)

PORT OF HAIFA (Jerusalem) — Depart the ship at 8am. We will be met by our Private Tour Guide and Transport for a Full Day of Touring. Our Tour will include:

A visit to **NAZARETH VILLAGE** – We'll walk through present day Nazareth (Mat. 2:19-23), the boyhood home of Jesus where we visit **MARY'S WELL** and the **CHURCH OF ANNUNCIATION** the traditional site of where the Angel Gabriel announced to Mary that she had been chosen to be the mother of Jesus. We'll visit **CAPERNAUM** (John 6:24) - home to Peter and the center of Jesus' preaching ministry. Nearby we stop at **CHURCH of the PRIMACY** (John 21: 15-17) – where we can actually dip our feet into the Galilee – and **TABGHA** (John 6:1), the traditional site which commemorates the miracle of the multiplication of the fish and loaves. We will also visit the **MOUNT of BEATITUDES** (Matt. 5) where we'll take time to [Reflect](#) on the words of Jesus spoken before the multitudes as He delivered His renowned 'Sermon on the Mount. We will take a **BOAT RIDE** across the Sea of Galilee (Mat. 14:25). Our boat docks at Kibbutz Nof Ginnosar where we'll see the remains of an ancient fishing boat dating from the time of Jesus – aptly referred to as the **JESUS BOAT**. We will stop for a traditional 'Peter's Fish Meal' at a Kibbutz before concluding this wonderful day with a memorable [BAPTISMAL SERVICE in the Jordan River](#) at **YARDENIT**.

RETURN to ship for Dinner. (Group dinner meal at 8:45pm)

NOTE: This Tour is included in the Trip Package Price. (Tips, Boat fee and Lunch meal not included)

DAY 11 & 12 WEDNESDAY & THURSDAY –(Oct 31st & Nov. 1st)

SEA DAYS— Relax, enjoy and explore the cruise ship. Start packing for the journey home. Morning Bible Class at 10am and Evening Service at 7pm.

We are blessed to have traveling with us Dr. Gaetano & Rev. Natalie Sicilia of Bible Faith Church in Toronto, Ontario. Along with Pastor Frey, we will be tremendously blessed by the anointed teaching and instruction we will receive during our trip. Bring your Bibles and a pen. Note sheets are included in your trip book.

On Thursday evening at 7pm we will have a special Testimony Service to close out our wonderful journey together. Our hearts will be forever changed after this incredible experience!

DAY 13 FRIDAY–NOVEMBER 2nd

RETURN HOME— Disembark the ship at 8am and be met by our private transport to the Istanbul airport for our departing flight home.

- Take time to reflect on all that you have seen and learned as you walked in the footsteps of the Apostle Paul and our Savior, Jesus! Treasure your memories of the fellowship and Biblical sites we've experienced!
- En route complimentary meals and beverages are served on board. Arrival at JFK International Airport the same day.

IMPORTANT TRIP NOTES:

- Due to unforeseen situations or time constraints due to traffic or other circumstances, the Trip Itinerary may change, or be altered in route or day to day if needed. We will do our best fit as much in our Tour Days as possible.
- It is highly recommended that you wear very comfortable walking shoes for the days you will spend touring. The streets in Turkey and Israel can be very rocking and uneven.
- Note, that on many of the touring days, we will depart early am and not return until late evening. It is highly recommended that you pack snacks/sandwiches/bottled water from the ship to take along with you.
- Each passenger is permitted one (50 lb) luggage bag and a small carry-on. There is a fee for each additional bag and overweight bags.
- Most of the entry fees are included in the Tour Prices, however, where they are not, you will need to have ready cash in US or Israeli dollars. Tips for the drivers/guides is preferred in US dollars.
- All prices quoted in this Trip Packet at in US dollars.

THE TRIP PACKAGE PRICE: The Trip Package Price is based on a minimum of **10** paying guests and on tariffs and rates in effect on March 1, 2011 and is subject to change without notice should there be a revision in rates prior to the departure or full payment received. Note: Airfare prices are subject to change by carrier until ticketed.

NOTE: A Non-refundable Administration/Service fee of \$125 applies to all cancellations.

Note: The airfare price is calculated based on roundtrip air from the following departure cities: Montreal (YUL), Toronto (YYZ), St. Louis (STL), Chicago (ORD), New York (JFK). If you depart from a different city or take an extension, additional cost may apply for your connection flight. Group prices are based on 10 or more travelling from a domestic city and are subject to change without notice. If the group decreases below 10 persons, the tour price may increase. The group may also be cancelled if it falls below the required minimum persons.

THE TRIP PACKAGE PRICE INCLUDES:

- A] SHIP ACCOMMODATIONS:** The Vision of the Seas has beautiful sleeping rooms and onboard amenities. There's the very soothing Day Spa, two pools, six whirlpools, and Theatre, Rock-climbing wall, stunning Centrum featuring shopping and more. Plus personal care and service each day by your room attendant, dinner servers, turn-down service each night, and other Royal Caribbean staff just waiting to make your stay onboard the adventure of a life-time. - [D] SIGHTSEEING:** The services of an English speaking guide are provided. **ALL** entrance fees to the sites as noted on the Trip Itinerary are included and transportation by private air-conditioned vehicle is included.
- [E] AIR TRANSPORTATION:** Air flights can be arranged independently or with the group air provided in the package through Faith Christian Center. If you require a CRUISE/TOUR ONLY price, please contact Faith Christian Center. **NOTE:** If you are travelling independently to Istanbul-Turkey, you will be responsible for securing and paying the extra transportation expense to catch up with the group or you may take a taxi or shuttle directly to the ship and check-in. If you cannot arrange your flight to arrive when the rest of the group arrives, you may choose to come a day early and stay overnight in Istanbul. We will gladly assist you with hotel arrangements at an additional cost. NOT INCLUDED IN THE TOUR PRICE:

TIPS/GRATUITIES: Royal Caribbean has set tipping guidelines for the onboard servers and attendants that serve you. You will receive a tipping guide onboard the ship. Tour drivers/guides tips are not included in the trip price. If you eat lunch while on tour neither the lunch meal or the tips are included. Daily tips/gratuities general range \$12-20 per day per person.
